Our NCGA qualifiers are over. Congratulations to those winners this year who will represent our club. Your Board voted to expand our perpetual trophies to include all NCGA events including, NCGA Zone Qualifier, NCGA Four-Ball Net Qualifier, NCGA Senior Four-Ball Net Qualifier and NCGA Net Amateur Qualifier. Winners this year will have their names engraved in perpetuity. We will also attempt to go back as far as we can in history, as our records will allow. These trophies become the history of our club.

Next up is our Member/Guest tournament on Saturday, August 11. More details are contained elsewhere in this Nugget and on the sign up announcement. A lunch will be included for this event. Sign up a friend that is not a member and come have some fun.

The major tournaments remaining for the year are Medal Play Championship in September, Senior Medal Play Championship in October and the wrap up Appreciation Tournament and dinner in November.

Our NCGA 12 man team competition, captained by Harry Phillips and Jim Pisula, is off to a respectable start. Initially, we tied Saddle Creek at their course, but, an error in Saddle Creek's line up caused a change in score giving Greenhorn Creek the win, 21 to 15. Unfortunately, we lost to Sequoia Woods at our course, 20 to 16. A win away is good. A loss at home is not good. The team will play on with high expectations and good leadership.

Our course markings are anticipated to be improved with broad stripes permanently marked on the cart paths for Lateral Hazard (red) and Out of Bounds (white). These stripes now become the official boundary lines where they exist. Stakes may be in place as well, but they serve as alerting the golfer to the condition from a distance. In the absence of a painted line, the line drawn between the stakes becomes the official boundary. Newly ordered score cards have been amended to reflect these new conditions. Your Board supported these changes.

You have been enjoying grass conditions at the driving range on Wednesdays, Thursdays and for major tournaments. Your Board supported this limited approach which should allow for the grass to heal on the other days. We thank the management for finding a workable compromise.
